## - Experiential Training

This training offers students who have completed two years of theoretical training at a University of Technology, the opportunity to gain practical workplace experience for a period of one year after which they will qualify for their respective National Diplomas.

## - Internships

Macsteel offers professionally qualified graduates the opportunity to obtain workplace experience for a period of three years in support of the qualification they have studied towards.
